Our Mission

Step strengthens our community by responding to the basic emergency needs of individuals and families in St. Louis Park.

Services

Food Shelf: Every day, 86+ families visit the STEP food shelf. The food shelf distributes more than 600,000 pounds of food to families in St. Louis Park every year. We also operate a holiday food program to ensure all families can enjoy a hearty meal together during the holidays.

Clothes Closet: STEP's Clothes Closet is a place where people can come to find free, gently used clothing.

Back to School Program: STEP provides school supplies to children who otherwise would not be equipped with the essential tools needed for success in school.

Rent & Mortgage Assistance: As resources are available, STEP provides families in crisis with money to pay rent and mortgages.

Transportation Services: STEP gives 2,000+ rides to seniors in our community every year and delivers prescriptions and groceries to homebound individuals.

Referrals and Social Work: STEP provides counseling, general support and guidance, advocacy and referrals to medical, mental health, child care, job training and other services through STEP's strategic partnerships.
