Year in Review

Fiscal 2020-2021

The St. Louis Park Emergency Program's mission is to identify, address and respond to the critical and emergency needs of residents in St. Louis Park. STEP provides direct assistance and support services to residents of St. Louis Park, targeting households with low incomes and those faced with financial crisis.



8,174 household client contacts with social workers.



\$768,058 in direct housing assistance was distributed to 251 households to prevent homelessness.

Program Expense: \$1,263,028



406,602 pounds of food among 4,165 households food shelf visits, an average of 45 pounds of food during each visit.

Food shelf and Social Work

Program Expense: \$1,147,619



STEP's clothing closet shut down in March 2019 due to COVID 19. 189 coats and winter wear items were distributed to adults and children.

Program Expense: \$11,161



STEP's transportation program resumed in February 2021 providing 6 people with rides to medical appointments. STEP's provided 479 deliveries, and \$1,210 in bus and gas certificates were distributed to help 97 individuals.

Program Expense: \$62,059



186 children received gift certificates for the holidays.

Program Expense: \$43,700



369 children received school supplies kits and 329 backpacks were distributed.

Program Expense: \$33,895

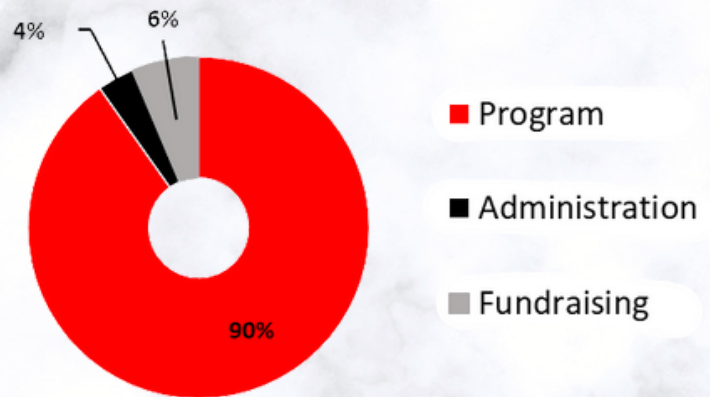

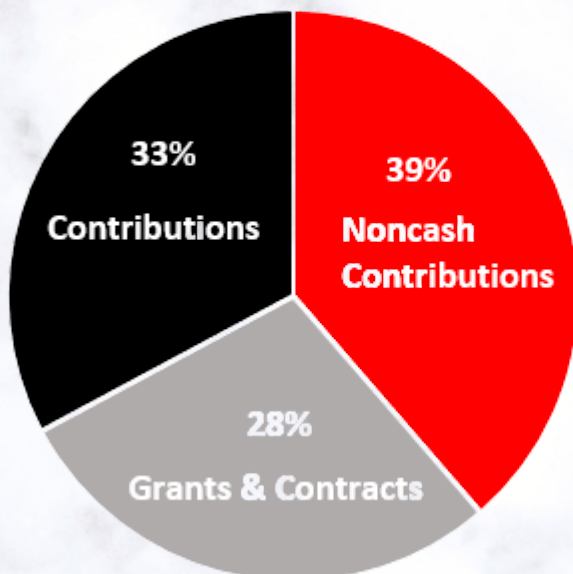
