# Year in Review

Fiscal 2021-2022

The St. Louis Park Emergency Program's mission is to identify, address and respond to the critical and emergency needs of residents in St. Louis Park. STEP provides direct assistance and support services to residents of St. Louis Park, targeting households with low incomes and those faced with financial crisis.



8,793 household client contacts with social workers.



\$63,913 in direct housing assistance was distributed to 48 households.

Program Expense: \$93,268



368,923 pounds of food distributed among 9,154 individuals.

Program Expense: \$1,189,339



346 coats and winter wear items were distributed to adults and children.

Program Expense: \$14,413



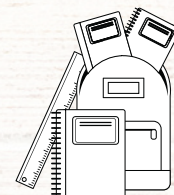
97 households received gas cards and bus passes. 87 rides were provided to medical and food shelf appointments.

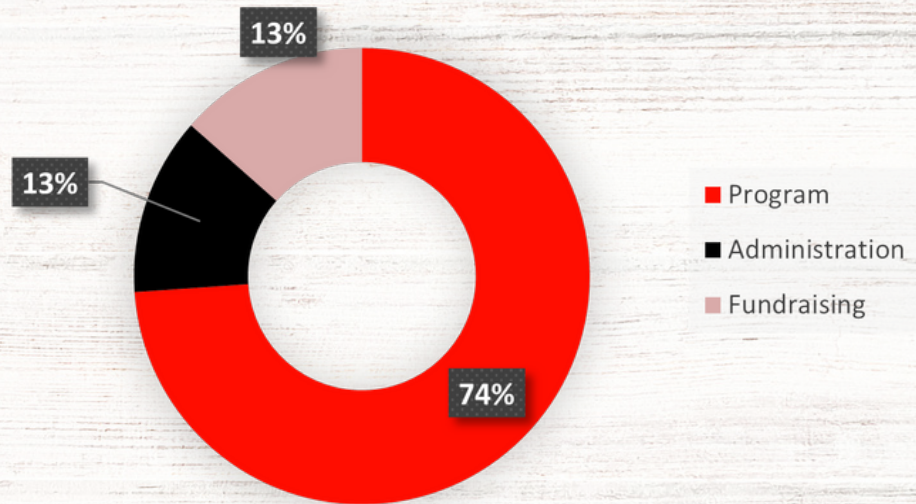

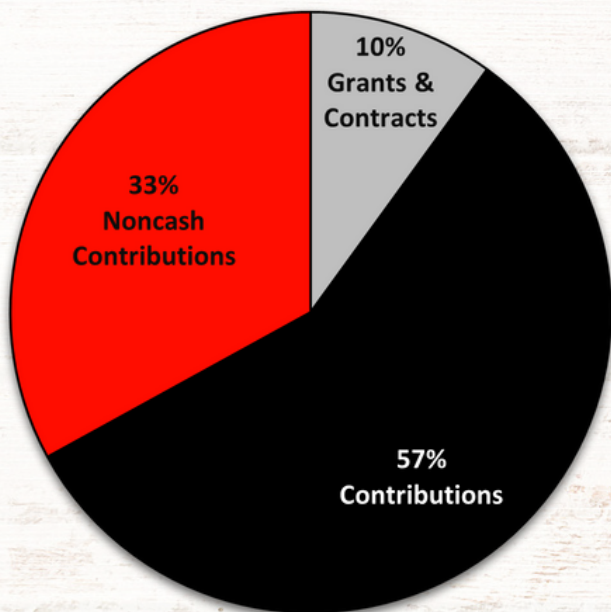
