Year in Review

Fiscal 2022-2023

The St. Louis Park Emergency Program's mission is to respond to neighbors in need by providing access to vital services that foster stability. STEP provides direct assistance and support services to residents of St. Louis Park, targeting households with low incomes and those faced with financial crisis.



10,096 household client contacts with social workers.



\$73,083.68 in direct housing assistance was distributed to 54 households to prevent homelessness.

Program Expense: \$133,302



367,267 pounds of food distributed among 11,219 individuals.

Program Expense: \$1,259,105



331 coats and winter wear items were distributed to adults and children.

Program Expense: \$27,968



144 individuals and families received gas cards and bus passes. 121 rides were provided to medical and food shelf appointments.

Program Expense: \$31,444



593 children received gifts and/or gift certificates for the holidays.

Program Expense: \$88,799



396 children received school supplies kits and 244 backpacks were distributed.




